## See some old masters that are not Vermeer

The Hermitage is presenting 35 paintings from the Leiden Collection in New York. The private collection consists of works by Rembrandt and his contemporaries, all of whom worked in Rembrandt's native city.

Artists include Pieter Lastman, Carel Fabritius, Arent de Gelder, Jan Lievens, Gerrit Dou, Frans van Mieris and Jan Steen. The unifying theme of the exhibition is history painting, a much prized genre in 17th century painting.
