



Eighteen works by Rembrandt are coming to the city for Amsterdam 750

Seventeen paintings and a drawing by Rembrandt are coming to Amsterdam this spring for a special exhibition in the H'ART Museum. The works come from a private collection and are exhibited for the 750th anniversary of the city.

According to the museum, it is the first time that the works are exhibited together. Three works are part of the series 'the five senses'. In addition, a self-portrait of the young Rembrandt from 1634 is on display.

The exhibition features a total of 75 works of art by 27 different makers, including a work by Vermeer. The exhibition is intended to show daily life in the 17th century.

The ordinary Amsterdammer

The works feature many women, from historical figures to women doing everyday things. Rembrandt was also known for painting not only the rich, but also the 'ordinary' Amsterdammer.

The exhibition, called From Rembrandt to Vermeer, masterpieces of The Leiden Collection, can be seen from 9 April to 24 August.
